SECTION 2 — CHATGPT

WHERE TO PASTE IT

ChatGPT has **two fields**. Each gets its own block below.

1. Open **chatgpt.com** and sign in.
2. Click your **profile icon** (bottom left).
3. Choose **Settings** → **Personalization** → **Custom Instructions**.
4. Paste **Field 1 text** into: "What would you like ChatGPT to know about you?"
5. Paste **Field 2 text** into: "How would you like ChatGPT to respond?"
6. Click **Save**.

SECTION 3 — GEMINI

WHERE TO PASTE IT

Gemini uses **Gems** — a named configuration you create once and select when you need it.

1. Go to gemini.google.com/gems.
2. Click **+ New Gem** (top left).
3. Name it: **"My Guardrail"**.
4. Paste the block below into the **Instructions** field.
5. Fill in your name and primary use in the two blanks.
6. Click **Save**.
7. To use it: select "My Guardrail" from your Gems list before starting a conversation.

Note: Google Workspace users (school or company accounts) may have Gems restricted by IT. If unavailable, use the ChatGPT version instead.
